Apparently residents as far away as floor 35 called the front desk concerned.

I installed an air quality monitor recently (in addition to smoke, gas, and CO) and the infiltrated smoke gave it a workout! I am still trying to make sense of the device's operation and reports, but in any case here in our apartment the Air Quality Index got as high as 210 and into the Very Unhealthful zone. (Normally the AQI is Good at 10 or less.)

I am concerned why the ordinary smoke alarm in the source apartment did not go off. This puts all of us residents at danger let alone the occupant of the apartment with the burning material. Perhaps we should revisit the sprinkler option as other buildings have.

Presumably Habitat's security log will provide further info. We'll see.
